2. Only horses registered to participate in the clinic are allowed on the grounds.
3. Only riders registered in the clinic are allowed to ride on the grounds.
4. Please leave your dogs at home!

5. ASTM/SEI certified headgear must be worn.
6. No overnight stabling will be provided. If you require stabling, please contact Tammy Henry (540-635-4549) for a list of local stables that may offer stalls.
7. Riders must be able to walk, job-trot, and lope-canter safely in a group in order to participate. Horse/Rider combinations deemed unsafe by the clinician will not be considered qualified for the State Show, and must qualify at another qualifying event.
8. Entries will be contacted either via phone or email to confirm entry receipt.
9. Refunds will be given if notice is given prior to May 21, 2008. After that, a veterinarian statement, or doctor's note will be required for a refund. No-shows will not receive a refund. Headquarters Place Farm is not responsible for accident or injury to horse, rider or spectator while attending or participating in this equine activity.
10. All riders, their parents/chaperones, clinicians and helpers (adults and youths) on the grounds must complete the Equine Release, Waiver and Indemnification form 388-035.
11. All participants must complete the 4-H Health and History Report form 388-906 and the 4-H Media Release form 388-054.
12. Forms noted in #10 and 11 above may be found on the 4-H Web Site below and must accompany the application for the clinic in order to be approved as a participant.
