DIVISIONS

BEGINNER: Open to any age rider and horse or pony.
Flat work only. NO jumping.

NOVICE: Open to any horse or pony. Fences not to exceed 2'.

INTERMEDIATE: Open to any horse or pony. Fences not to exceed 2'9"

ADVANCED: Open to any horse or pony. Fences not to exceed 3'6".

PHASES (Ph)

Ph 1: Flat work only. No jumping.

Ph 2: Will include flat work and gymnastic exercises.

Ph 3: Will include stadium jumping only.

Ph 4: Will include stadium jumping and cross country jumping.
