## SPECIAL INFORMATION FOR PARENTS:

1. Youth 5-8 years of age (as of January 1, 2004) from any county in Southwest Virginia may attend.
2. There will be a teen counselor or adult staff member for each 5 campers.
3. Arrival time will be 5:30 p.m. on Friday, March 26, and departure time will be 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, March 27.
4. A qualified medical person will be on duty at all times during camp. All medication must be clearly marked and turned in upon arrival.
5. A health form (physical not required), list of items to bring, directions, and other information will be sent after registration has been received.
6. The \$26 camp fee is non-refundable after March 19, 2004.

## WHAT IS CLOVERBUD CAMP?



Cloverbud Camp is designed to offer five to eight-year-olds the opportunity to experience the excitement of overnight camping. This camp is designed to give a younger child the opportunity to spend a night away from home, meet new people, learn new things, and most importantly, have fun.

## FACILITIES AND STAFF

The Southwest Virginia 4-H Educational Center is located near Abingdon, Virginia. Children will "camp out" inside Ratliff Hall. They will be chaperoned by teen counselors and adult volunteers, at a ratio of one counselor to five youth. Meals will be served in the 4-H Center dining hall.



Lots of interesting classes and activities will be offered during this unique Cloverbud "camp in". The theme is "Carnivale" and many activities will revolve around activities and events that may occur at a carnival or county fair. Classes will include activities in dance, music, nature studies, cooperation with others, food preparation, and much more!

Of course no camping experience is complete without programs around a fire. Songs, cheers, and stories will be enjoyed around the rustic stone fireplace in Ratliff Hall.



## CAMP FEE

The camp fee is \$26 per child, which includes three meals (Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast, and lunch), nutritious snacks, lodging, insurance, and program supplies.

Your child should not bring any money to camp. Everything is included in the camp fee.

Camp is limited to 15 boys and 15 girls. Registrations will be accepted on a first come basis.
