EXHIBITORS MUST BE CURRENTLY-ENROLLED MEMBERS OF 4-H OR FFA IN VIRGINIA.

1. Heifers may arrive beginning at 8:00 am on Friday, April 21. **Barn Space Will Not Be Available Before This Time!** Heifers must be in place by 5 pm on Saturday, April 21. Check-in for heifers will take place from 1 to 5 pm.
2. Shows are scheduled as follows: Other Registered Breeds at 6:00 pm on Saturday, April 21 and Commercial Heifers at 9:00 am on Sunday, April 22.
3. All Heifers must be born on or after June 1, 2005, and owned by the exhibitor.
4. Exhibitors must have their 9th birthday by September 30, 2007 and not have had their 19th birthday before January 1, 2007.
5. Classes will be determined after all entries are received, and will be established by age of the heifer.
6. Heifers will be shown dry. No artificial substances may be applied to the hair. No butt fans are allowed.
7. Other Registered Heifers are breeds other than Angus, Simmental, Hereford, Red Angus, and Shorthorn. Heifer must be owned, in care of, and registration transferred to the name of the exhibitor by January 1, 2007.
8. Commercial Replacement Heifers are less than 3/4 blood, unregistered, grade, or crossbreds.
9. **Youth exhibitors are expected to be the primary care provider for their cattle. Assistance on show day may only be provided by the parents or other members of the immediate family, a bona fide 4-H volunteer leader, Extension Agent, FFA Instructor, or another youth exhibitor with cattle entered in the show**
9. An entry fee of \$8.00 per heifer must accompany your entry with check payable to Virginia 4-H Foundation.
10. **Entries must be postmarked by - March 31, 2007.**
