Expectations at a Glance

- Represent the needs and interests of 4-H youth in your District
- Positively represent 4-H at the local, District, and state levels. Demonstrate the best that 4-H has to offer through your words, actions, and personal appearance.
- Purchase a green blazer (\$75.00). The total cost for a blazer is \$130.00 however; the Virginia 4-H Foundation pays the additional cost as well as for the ties for the males.
- Promote 4-H to youth and adults at the local, District, and state levels
- Attend four (4) meetings over the next year scheduled for August 1-3, 2008 at Airfield 4-H Educational Center, November 14-16, 2008 at Holiday Lake 4-H Educational Center, January 28-29, 2009 in Richmond, VA, and May 22-24, 2009 at Virginia Tech- missing two (2) meetings results in immediate removal from Cabinet. Arriving late and leaving early may be considered as a “missed meeting” depending on the circumstances. In other words, *you must commit yourself to this leadership and service opportunity.*
- Attend the 2009 State 4-H Congress, June 15-18, 2009
- Be prepared to develop a collaborative relationship with peers (youth) and adults. We will work towards a youth-adult partnership. See your *Member Handbook* for more information about youth adult partnerships.
- Be prepared to laugh, to share ideas, to “argue” your positions and perspectives, to give and receive constructive criticism, to develop friendships, and to make a difference in the lives of others.
